







The 19th Centropa Summer Academy 20th c. European History. Holocaust. Jewish Memory.

9-16 July 2025 ~ Budapest and Belgrade

Learn about Holocaust history with teachers who live and teach in the lands where the Holocaust took place.

Centropa on the Danube – join 60 teachers from the US, Europe, and Israel as we turn Budapest and Belgrade into classrooms for studying the Holocaust, 20th c. European History, and Jewish life before the war. Highlights include:

Budapest: tour the Dohany Synagague, the Danube Shoe Memorial, the Holocaust Museum, and the city with expert guides; meet Holocaust survivors from the Budapest Jewish community; attend a Shabbat service; learn about Communism in Hungary and life since the fall of Communism.

Enroute to Belgrade: we will stop in Subotica to visit their newly renovated, art nouveau style synagogue, then to Novi Sad where we will take a short walking tour of Jewish Novi Sad and visit the monument to the victims of the raid in Novi Sad in WWII.

Belgrade: walk in the footsteps of the Kalef family, Centropa interviewees; tour Jewish Belgrade; visit Staro Sajmiste, a concentration camp during the German occupation; explore Serbia's bustling capital; Sephardic music concert; visit the Jewish cemetery.

You will return home with knowledge about the Holocaust in Hungary, Sephardic Jews in the Balkans and their fate during the Holocaust, engaging resources, project ideas from fellow teachers, and opportunities for your students to learn with students in other countries.
