BHEC WELCOMES FORMER U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE MADELEINE ALBRIGHT AND AUBURN UNIVERSITY'S HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH BRUCE PEARL GUEST SPEAKERS FOR L'CHAIM 2020



July 8, 2020 -- The Birmingham Holocaust Education Center and Co-Chairs Kate Cotton, Cathy O. Friedman, and Jim Richardson present *L'Chaim* ("to life") 2020 virtual event on August 23 at 2:00 p.m. live online at https://doi.org/bheclchaim.swell.gives. The annual event will honor Susan and David Silverstein, for their strong commitment to the BHEC's vision and mission. The *L'Chaim* program is a combination of entertainment, education, and recognition. The program will feature virtual performances arranged by Keith Cromwell of Red Mountain Theatre Company and will include keynotes from special guests, Former U.S. Secretary of State Madeleine Albright, and Auburn University's Head Men's Basketball Coach Bruce Pearl.



Dr. Albright, and Coach Pearl will share words of hope, empowerment, and why Holocaust education is critical today. "Now more than ever, the BHEC is dedicated to preserving and sharing our Alabama Holocaust Survivors' stories, which are powerful reminders to us all, of the consequences of hate, and silence in the face of hate. Even during this challenging COVID-19 pandemic, we are empowering teachers and our greater community through Holocaust education online workshops," says **Rev. Melissa Self Patrick, Executive Director of Birmingham Holocaust Education Center**. The Anti-Defamation League's recent audit of antisemitic incidents shows a 12% increase overall, and the US Justice Department and FBI statistics on hate crimes show steady growth over the last four years in hate crimes directed against individuals because of race, religion, or sexual orientation.

L'Chaim is the culmination of the BHEC's annual fundraising campaign.
