LONDON, Nov. 18.—The Daily Express said today that Scotland Yard had uncovered a marriage bureau specializing in providing British nationality for wealthy German women refugees.

The Express asserted that agents of the bureau had been approaching laborers, lorry drivers and unemployed men with offers of \$300 and expenses, including a new suit,

if they would marry German Jewish women.

The agents stipulated that the bridegroom must sign a pledge not to approach the bride after the ceremony.
